



ISOLMANT FASCIA PERIMETRALE TECNICA DOPPIO SPESSORE

Adhesive perimeter bands designed for an easy installation, made of a vertical part in 5 mm semi adhesive polyethylene to be applied to the wall and an horizontal one made of a 0,1 mm HDPE film with adhesive silicon paper on the lower side. Available in 28 cm (18 cm on the wall and 10 cm on the slab). These bands come with a screen-printed side with installation instructions.

FLANKING PATH NOISE REDUCTION	The non-use of Isolmant Fascia Perimetrale causes an acoustic bridge and a consequent decibel loss
INSTALLATION	Isolmant Fascia Perimetrale Tecnica Doppio Spessore is suitable for installation over the resilient layer due to its silicone adhesive paper film on the bottom sides. Trim the extra length only after laying and grouting tiles and before installing the skirting boards.
SIZE	Strips of 28 cm x 50 m
PACKAGING	4 strips (equal to 200 m)

→ Conditions of use

To ensure the good functioning of the floating floor, it is also essential to insulate the vertical surfaces of the flooring screed. To do this, as an alternative to the "fold" of the resilient layer, often difficult during construction, it is sufficient to apply Isolmant Fascia Perimetrale to the foot of the wall and around the perimeter.

→ Item specifications

Adhesive double thickness perimeter strips designed for easy installation, which consist of a vertical side made of expanded cross-linked polyethylene with 5 mm thickness. This side is partially adhesive and it is conceived to be installed on the wall. The horizontal part is made of an HDPE film with 0.1 mm thickness and silicone adhesive paper on the lower sides for installation over the resilient layer. Height 28 cm high strips packed in 4 rolls box of 200 m each.
